The petitioner is seeking direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to investigate the matter regarding death of his daughter at her matrimonial house, on the basis of representation dated 16.12.2015 (Annexure P-3).

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4, in the shape of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dharamkot, District Moga, has been filed in Court. Same is taken on record. In the affidavit, it is stated that as per enquiry report (Annexure R-1/T), Charanjit Kaur, daughter of the petitioner, was having a stone problem and she was undergoing treatment from a hospital at Ferozepur. Thereafter, she was

admitted in Guru Nanak Mission Hospital, Jalandhar for conducting an

operation, where she died on 30.11.2015 during operation. As per opinion of the doctor, she had died 'due to sudden cardiac arrest'. Cremation of Charanjit Kaur was performed on 30.11.2015 at village Sherpur Taiban in the presence of her parental family. It was recommended to consign the application in the record room.

In view of the reply filed, no further directions are required to be given in this petition.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition.
