JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 for registration of case against respondents No. 4 to 6 for criminal trespass and for destruction of the crops of the petitioner on the basis of representation moved by him (Annexure P-10).

2. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated 04.05.2016 (Annexure P-10) was moved to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali but till date no action has been

taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali, Punjab to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 04.05.2016 (Annexure P-10) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
