The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a complaint filed by Mewa Singh son of Sh. Bant Singh before Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samrala, District Ludhiana.

During the course of arguments, counsel would concede that the complaint lodged by the complainant party is still at the stage of inquiry/investigation. The complaint having not culminated in the registration of an F.I.R, this Court would not be inclined to examine the prayer of the petitioner for grant of concession of anticipatory bail, at this stage.

Petition is, accordingly, disposed of as premature.

It is, however, made clear that in case the complaint fructifies into registration of an F.I.R, it would always be open for the petitioners herein to seek appropriate remedy as may be available to them strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
