Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to carry out a fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No. 59 dated June 22, 2015 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot with further prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well his family members, who are apprehending threat to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. During the course of arguments, it has been emerged that petitioner is satisfied in case representation dated January 07, 2016 (Annexure P-6) is enquired into and disposed of by respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot to enquire into the allegations levelled in representation (Annexure P-6) and if some substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of certified copy of this order.
