After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all her pleas before the trial court at an appropriate stage. She further submits that personal appearance of the petitioners may be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

In case, petitioners move an application for exemption of their personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioners on such terms and conditions as it deems proper to impose. Petitioners may be allowed to appear through their counsel except on the dates when their presence is necessary.
