JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner-accused-Sarabjit Saini alias Sonnu in case FIR No. 136, dated 09.09.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 20/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

As per allegations, 1.500 kgs. of *Charas* from the car being driven by the petitioner-accused was recovered, which falls under commercial category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a false case has been planted upon the petitioner and he is not involved in any other case. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 09.09.2015 and trial is not likely to be concluded in near future. Thus, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Keeping in view the serious nature of allegations and the fact that recovery of contraband is commercial in nature, no case for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
