Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent no.4 to 7.

Pursuant to order dated 23.5.2016, the petitioner no.2 was required to bring an FDR in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- in favour of petitioner no.1. However, the petitioner no.2 has failed to comply with the aforesaid order. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed for non-prosecution.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has filed statement of petitioner no.1 recorded by the police, in Court, to the effect that there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners and therefore, they do not require any police protection.

In view of the statements so recorded, the present petition is dismissed.
