This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.203 dated 20.08.2014, registered under Sections 21/22-61-85 NDPS Act, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 30.11.2015. Learned Deputy Advocate General states that eight witnesses remain to be examined and the prosecution undertakes to conclude its evidence within three months (subject to the fact that the petitioner does not obstruct the same).

In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the

learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence within three months (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
