This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.69 dated 24.04.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise dated 07.05.2016.

The parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to record their statements, vide order dated 23.05.2016. As per report of learned JMIC, Dasuya dated 13.09.2016, the parties did not cause representation to record their statements.

Keeping in view the fact that the parties have failed to comply with the order dated 23.05.2016, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to revive the same within six weeks from today, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- towards costs of litigation to be paid to the State of Punjab.
