Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.53 dated 2.4.2010 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC and Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act, registered at Police Station Malout City, District Muktsar.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jitender Singh states that in the case in hand the police after investigating the case has submitted the cancellation report with the Court and the Court has accepted the same. Accordingly, the FIR in question does not survive.

Considering the facts that the police has already submitted the cancellation report, which has been accepted by the trial Court, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
