KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 praying for the issuance of a direction to the respondents No. 2, 3 and 4 to not to take any coercive action against the petitioner and not to threaten him to falsely implicate in an FIR or harass him.

The petitioner has some rent dispute with his land lord which happens to be a Non Resident Indian (NRI). It appears that the landlord has filed some complaint. The petitioner claimed that despite the order of the Civil Court, he is being threatened by the landlord.

Let the petitioner appear before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and state his grouse.

Since, this Court is not aware about the complaints and cross complaints filed by both the parties, therefore, the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the matter in accordance with law.

In view of the above the present petition stands disposed of.
