JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to initiate an appropriate legal action against the private respondents i.e. respondents No.4 and 5 and their unidentified henchmen involved in the murder of his mother Harvinder Kaur in respect of which FIR No.31 dated 03.03.2016, under Section 302 of IPC and 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Division B has been registered.

At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Pragat Singh that on conclusion of the investigation in the above referred FIR, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented on 12th August, 2016 against respondent No.4. However, culpability of no other person was established but after framing of the charges, now the case is listed for

prosecution evidence.

In view of the submission of the report in the Court and after conclusion of the trial, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and it stand disposed of accordingly.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved, he can have recourse to the remedies available to him under law.
