Prayer in this application is for placing on record the statement
of PW1-complainant as Annexure P3.

Application is allowed and the statement of complainant as
Annexure P3 is taken on record.

CRM-M-17957 of 2016

Prayer in this application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for
grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.47 dated 10.2.2015,

under Sections 302, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sampla,
District Rohtak.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh states that in the case in hand the case is at the verge of its completion as against the total 24 prosecution witnesses, 19 have already been examined. Only the Investigating Officer and other formal witnesses are required to be examined and the next date fixed in the case is 24.8.2016.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, however, states that since the petitioner is in custody since 12.2.2015, the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial and to conclude the same preferably within 3 months from 24.8.2016.

The prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner seems to be fair.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage, however, with liberty to the petitioner that in case the trial is not concluded within a period of 3 months from 24.8.2016, he would be at liberty to move application seeking regular bail before the trial Court and the trial Court shall consider the same in accordance with law.
