Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.42 dated 04.05.2015, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahar.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is of 2000 ml. of intoxicant liquid and which as per report of the Chemical Examiner was found to be containing Diacetylmorphine.

The same would be construed as commercial quantity.

Prayer of the petitioner seeking benefit of regular bail is declined.

Petition dismissed.
