This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated
18.02.2016, registered under Sections 420, 406 IPC, at Police Station

Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

On 23.05.2016 the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Chamkaur Singh alleging that the petitioner had taken a jointly owned tractor trolley and did not return the same to the complainant who happens to be the uncle of the petitioner.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab for 23.08.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on or before 4.6.2016. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 23.05.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
