A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties and perused the FIR in question, namely, FIR No.567 dated 26.11.2015, registered under Section 365 IPC at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel appearing for UT Chandigarh fairly makes a statement, upon instructions from the concerned Investigating Officer, that the girl is major, aged about 28 years and has made a statement even before the Magistrate under Section 164 Cr.P.C. that on her own she left her place. This Court had made an order on 23.5.2016 to join the investigation. Accordingly, the petitioner has joined the investigation, as stated by Learned Counsel for the State. In that view of the matter, the order dated 23.5.2016 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to remain on bail till the conclusion of the trial.
