The petitioner seeks concession of bail in a case registered at the instance of Amar Singh alleging that on 27.12.2015 the complainant along with his wife and brother had gone to fields to irrigate the land. He was armed with a .12 bore rifle. He was waylaid by the petitioner and five other persons. The brother of the petitioner, Charna Singh, snatched gun from him and fired five gun shots, three on the complainant and two on his wife Balbir Kaur.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he allegedly grappled with the complainant along with other co-accused and snatched the gun. He was armed with soti but no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 14.1.2016. Challan has already been presented.

Counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose the bail application contending that the petitioner, as a member of unlawful assembly, specifically participated and facilitated the snatching of rifle.

Without expression of any opinion on merit and keeping in view the role of the co-accused of the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
