Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Lovleen Kaur alleging that the petitioner had prepared a forged agreement dated 30.4.2008 and made an attempt to usurp the property of the petitioner while she was in Canada. The said agreement has been held to be an invalid document by the Civil Court.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that Ranbir Singh and Jaspal Singh, co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail by this Court on 12.1.2016.

With the assistance of counsel for the petitioner, I have gone through the agreement dated 30.4.2008 which is stated to have been fabricated by the petitioner. A perusal of said document indicates that Ranbir Singh and Jaspal Singh were the attesting witnesses but the agreement appears to have been prepared in

favour of Sarabjit Singh petitioner. He only appears to be the beneficiary of the said fake agreement of mortgage.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that appeal is pending against the order passed by the civil Court.

After hearing the counsel for the petitioner and going through the agreement, I am of the opinion that the case of the petitioner is not at par with that of the case of his co-accused.

No ground is made out to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.

Nothing said in this order will prejudice the right of the petitioner to seek concession of regular bail.
