After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all the pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage. He, however, prays that the personal appearance of the petitioners, who are said to be connived with the main accused, before the trial court may be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case the petitioners move an application for exemption of their personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioners on such terms & conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The petitioners may be allowed to appear through their counsel except on the dates her presence is necessary.
