Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the interim order dated 23.05.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.363 dated 28.04.2016, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Petitioners are women and are alleged to have found in unlawful assembly and assaulted the complainants. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Ramesh Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation. She further states that since the petitioners had found in unlawful assembly, the matter is serious.

In my opinion, the petitioners being women and interim order dated 23.05.2016 having been complied with, the same need to be confirmed.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 23.05.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
