JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to accused petitioner-Major Singh in case FIR No.88 dated 30.5.2010 for offences punishable under Sections 323/324/34 Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on) Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

Petitioner accused was attributed *datar* blows on the left hand of complainant on the day of occurrence i.e. 19.5.2010. He was enlarged on bail. However, he jumped bail on 23.1.2013 and thereafter declared a PO on 9.6.2014. Now petitioner has approached this Court for anticipatory bail to face trial.

It is submitted that parties have now effected an amicable

settlement in petition bearing CRM-M 14934/2016 seeking quashing of the FIR itself which is listed for 2.6.2016.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned Counsel for the Lrs of the complainant acknowledges that the compromise has been affected with the petitioner-accused, has no objection if the interim order is confirmed.

Faced with the stand of the complainant party, learned State counsel assisted by ASI Major Singh does not oppose the confirmation of the interim bail granted to the petitioner.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 23rd of May, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
