This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.14 dated 02.02.2016 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station-Daba , Ludhiana.

As per the allegations, the petitioner impersonated another person/challenged sale deed and thereby duped an amount of Rs. 10,00,000/-
Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in

custody for seven months and trial is not likely to be heard in near future. He

further states that trial has not been started but the challan has been presented.

Learned counsel for the complainant on the other hand argues that the petitioner is accused of forgery and serious offence and impersonation where punishment can be extended up to life imprisonment. He further states that the petitioner is also accused in another FIR under Section 306 IPC where also he duped a person who later committed suicide.

Learned Addl. A.G has accepted these factual assertions.

Be that as it may. In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
