The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.480 dated 04.09.2015, registered under Sections 341, 302, 307, 120-B and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Kundli, Distt. Sonipat.

Learned counsel contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. She is only shown to be present on the spot and incited the assailants to cause injuries. In the supplementary statement of the complainant, the petitioner is not even named. She is in custody since 06.09.2015.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has been specifically named in the FIR and her active participation in the crime is made out. Out of twenty five prosecution

witnesses, examination-in-chief of one witness has been recorded.

Heard.

The petitioner is a household lady and not involved in any other FIR. No injury has been attributed to her. She has not been named in the supplementary statement of the complainant. The challan stands already filed. Out of 25 prosecution witnesses, only examination in chief of one witness has been recorded, therefore, the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonipat.

However, nothing noticed hereinabove shall be construed as an expression of opinion of this Court, on the merits of the case.
