In FIR No.114 dated 10.08.2014 registered under Sections 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, the accused as well as complainant have arrived at compromise (Annexure P-2) in order to live in peace and harmony.

Looking to the nature of offences registered under Sections 324 and 34 of IPC in said FIR and in view of the fact that the statements have been recorded by the concerned Magistrate and forwarded to this Court through District & Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, wherein it is stated that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the same is genuine.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.114 dated 10.08.2014

registered under Sections 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
