Reply filed in Court on behalf of the State is taken on record.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.53 dated 1.4.2015 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P1) along with all the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Nakodar received. Learned magistrate has recorded the statements of both the parties. It is reported that the parties have compromised the

matter and the same is without any pressure or coercion.

Perusal of file shows that it was a money dispute on account of promise to send the son of the complainant to Spain.

Since the money dispute has been amicably settled, therefore, FIR No.53 dated 1.4.2015 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P1) along with all the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition stands allowed.
