is for issuing direction to the respondents to initiate action in case
FIR No.03 dated 09.1.2014, under Sections 447, 506 and 120-B IPC,
registered at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana City, District
Ludhiana. Prayer has also been made to protect the life, liberty
and property of the petitioner, who is stated to be a senior citizen.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balkar

Singh and by making reference to the reply submits that the police has investigated the matter and accordingly prepared a cancellation report, which has been submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate on 14.3.2016 and the same is now pending for consideration before the learned Magistrate for 18.5.2016.

Taking into consideration the fact that the police has conducted the investigation and has submitted a cancellation report, no further order is required to be passed in this petition by this Court.

Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file protest petition, if he finds that the cancellation report is being accepted by the trial Court.
