FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 15th September, 2015 of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received based on the statements of complainant-Gurnam Singh and accused/petitioner-Sawinder Singh to vouch over the compromise, it has been revealed before this Court that accused/petitioner-Sawinder Singh is a proclaimed offender, apparently, the Court below having declared him to be a proclaimed offender, has failed to arrest when he appeared before the Court to make such statement.

Since, the accused/petitioner-Sawinder Singh is a proclaimed

offender and today there is no representation on his behalf. Keeping in view that as per the settled proposition of law a proclaimed offender is not entitled to such discretionary relief as he is evading law. Since, nothing survives in this petition, same stands disposed off as dismissed.

Learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar be apprised of this situation and to be careful in future.
