JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.100, dated 03.12.2015, under Sections 392, 364-A, 347, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala, Punjab (Annexure P-1) alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 22.12.2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. In compliance of order dated February 09, 2016, report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have voluntarily entered into the compromise between themselves and have settled the matter

amicably. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.100, dated 03.12.2015, under Sections 392, 364-A, 347, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala, Punjab and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
