JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3 and his subordinate staff and further issuance of appropriate directions to respondent No.3 and his subordinate staff to not to harass and humiliate the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion to respondents.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated 27.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved to the

Commissioner of Police, Amritsar but no action has been taken so far.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, Punjab to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 27.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
