1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.4 in case FIR No.232 dated 15.8.2014 under Sections 379, 427 and 447 IPC registered at Police Station Dhramkot, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the aforesaid FIR was registered on 15.8.2014, but the investigation in the case has not been completed so far. He further submits that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already approached respondent

No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga by way of representation dated 20.10.2015 (Annexure P-2), but no action thereon has been taken by the police.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case as well as investigation in the FIR in question, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of representation (Annexure P-2), stated to have been filed by the petitioner on 20.10.2015, and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
