The petitioners have challenged the summoning order dated 21.11.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Roopnagar, passed in a criminal complaint titled as Paramjit Singh Vs. Jasbir Singh and others. He also seeks quashing of the complaint.

The petitioner is relegated to avail remedy of the revision before the Sessions Court first. If the petition is filed before 30 days from today, the Sessions Court shall entertain the petition and dispose of the same on merits notwithstanding the bar of limitation.
