Report dated 05.07.2016 sent by Sub divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Kuldip Singh, Manbeer Singh @ Laddi and Dilbag Singh @ Bagga as well as of complainant Karam Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that offences are not serious in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543 Kulwinder Singh** and **others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.156 dated 30.12.2015 under Sections 452/427/506/380/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station, Raja Sansi

District Amritsar (Rural) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
