The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No. 27 dated 06.02.2016 registered under Sections 148, 149, 120-B, 323, 324, 326, 451 IPC at Police Station Division Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that neither the petitioner is named in the FIR and nor there is any specific injury attributed to him much less the injury attracting the offence under Section 326 IPC. He has further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 10.02.2016 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, Police Station Phillaur, confirms the above said averments while stating that the petitioner was one of the unknown persons attributed with general injuries to the injured- Ravi Kumar, therefore, this petition should be dismissed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered

just and expedient to allow this petition.

Consequently, the petitioners shall be released on bail pending trial subject to their furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
