The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 61, dated 26.11.2015, under Sections 406 and 420 I.P.C., registered at Police Station Qilla Lal Singh, Batala, District Gurdaspur on the basis of complaint of respondent No. 2, namely Pal Singh, alleging that the petitioners, in connivance with one Jeewan Singh, had duped the complainant of a sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- on the pretext of sending the son of the complainant, namely Lakhwinder Singh, to Malaysia on work Visa.

The matter has been compromised between the parties. The Statements of the parties have already been recorded.

As per the statements of the parties recorded by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Batala, pursuant to the directions of the Court, a report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, undue influence or coercion.

Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulvinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, I am of the opinion that since the complainant is not left with any grievance against the accused persons, the matter can be permitted to be quashed on the basis of the compromise.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
