The petitioners allegedly assaulted complainant/
respondent No. 2, namely Inderjeet Singh, on 31.10.2015 and also
hurt his religious sentiments by entering into the Gurudwara
Sahib, allegedly after consumption of liquor.

As per the statements of the parties recorded by
Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, pursuant to the
directions of the Court, a report has been received that the matter

has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, undue influence or coercion.

The petition is allowed in view of Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulvinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
