JASPAL SINGH, J.

Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.101, dated 06.06.2015, under Section 3(x) Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and 506 IPC, Police Station SAS Nagar, Phase-I, Mohali, along with all consequential proceedings arising thereof, on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated 25.07.2016, report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been observed that compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which

has been amicably put at rest. Compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances and in view of the pronouncement captioned as Kulwinder Singh & others v. State of Punjab & others; 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.101, dated 06.06.2015, under Section 3(x) Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and 506 IPC, Police Station SAS Nagar, Phase-I, Mohali, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
