This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.38 dated 25.04.2016 registered under Sections 420 and 120B IPC at Police Station-Khanauri, Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners are in custody more than four months and it is a case of magisterial trial.

Learned DAG on instructions from Investigating Officer has accepted these factual assertions and learned counsel for the complainant is not in a position to deny these facts.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
