Status report by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, City, Gurgaon with regard to medical condition of the petitioner's father has been filed in the Court, today and the same is taken on record. Copy has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Perusal of the status report would reveal that father of the petitioner, namely, Mehtab is admitted in the Safdurjang Hospital at New Delhi on bed No.16, Ward No.31 as he has to undergo the surgery of Transurethral Resection of Bladder Tumour (TURBT) as per report of Dr. Anup Kumr, Medical Officer. State report further reveals that Mehtab has two sons i.e. the present petitioner and Sandeep and both of them are in judicial Custody at Bhondsi Jail and one daughter, who is married and staying separately in her matrimonial home. Wife of Mehtab is stated to be 60 years of age and also not keeping good health.

Learned counsel for the petitioner informs the Court that the surgical procedure on Sh. Mehtab father of the petitioner is now slated for 16.06.2016.

In the light of the status report filed in the Court, today, the prayer of the petitioner seeking interim bail for a period of four days commencing from 15.06.2016 is accepted.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner would be taken in custody on 15.06.2016 itself to the hospital Safdurgang at New Delhi to facilitate the petitioner to take care of his father at the pre-operative and the post operation stage. The petitioner would be taken back in the evening of 18.06.2016.

Expenses of travelling to the hospital on 15.06.2016 and returning on 18.06.2016 would be borne by the petitioner.

The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
