Petitioner while in custody in another case along with co-accused allegedly made a confessional statement, regarding involvement in the present case, which was registered at the instance of Hatesh Dogra alleging that while he was on his way home on Swift car, he was stopped by three boys, who broke open the window and took the keys of the car. The car was taken away along with mobile phone of the complainant. The petitioner having been involved in the case on the basis of statement made in police custody in another case, involvement of the petitioner in the present case will certainly be a debatable issue.

The petitioner having been taken in custody w.e.f. 16.3.2016 in a blind FIR, can be granted the concession of bail, as his identity will certainly be a debatable issue.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
