This petition will dispose of the aforesaid three petitions, filed by the petitioners namely, Prince, Kulwinder Singh and Gurdeep Singh respectively in a case of assault registered at the instance of Ravi Kumar alleging that he was present in his shop when 6 to 7 persons came in a car armed with baseball bats, datar etc. and trespassed the shop of the complainant and assaulted the complainant causing injuries

on his head, index finger, left wrist and back side of his head and shoulders. As per the suspicion of the complainant, he had on an earlier occasion i.e. on 17.01.2016 had entered into a quarrel with Hanish Kumar, Tilak Ram and Harmesh Lal. The accused, in the present case, had allegedly been sent by the said persons as they had threatened the complainant on 17.01.2016.

None of the accused persons has been named in the FIR. No specific injury has been attributed to the accused individually. The petitioners have been in custody with effect from 07.03.2016. The challan has already been presented. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody during the entire period of trial.

All petitions are allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioners will not indulge in similar activity, for which they are accused of, in the present case.
