The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 19 dated 18.11.2015 registered at Police Station Women, Sirsa, District Sirsa under Sections 363, 366-A, 376(2)(n), 506 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 30.11.2015 and Girdhari is the main accused and there are no allegations of rape against the petitioner. He further states that the allegations were that 3-4 men took the victim in a bus and came to Chandigarh from Sirsa. He further states that the prosecutrix had approached the High Court for protection and refers to Annexure P-2.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
