The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.146 dated 11.08.2015, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at P.S. Ghall Khurd, Distt. Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the sample was not taken from each and every strip. He is not involved in any other FIR.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the report of the chemical examination has been received which shows that the recovery is commercial in nature.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In this case, the contraband recovered from the petitioner falls under the category of commercial quantity and the bar of Section 37 NDPS
