By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.22, dated 11.02.2016, registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') and Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC (added later on) and Sections 80 and 82 of the Registration Act, at Police Station Shimla Puri, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 01.06.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that the petitioner is a mother of two minor children.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.06.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
