Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Gurdeep Kumar @ Deepa in case FIR No.284 dated 28.09.2013 for offences punishable under Sections 382, 392, 411 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 10.03.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled on account of his absence on 14.10.2015. He again applied and got anticipatory bail from the learned Sessions Court on 08.02.2016 with direction to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days and as such was released on interim bail.

Petitioner could not appear and again he approached the Court

and got bail with another direction to appear before the Court before

10.03.2016.

It is submitted that the petitioner could not appear before the Court on aforesaid date on account of he being suffering from TB.

Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

It is conceded fact that petitioner has not filed any application seeking exemption from personal appearance. Further he is involved in the commission of heinous offence.

Keeping in view the above conduct of the petitioner, his involvement in the serious offence and the fact that the trial is being delayed on account of his non appearance, no indulgence can be shown to such an accused by granting him concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
