TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.44 dated 12.08.2015, under Sections 379/447/431/149 IPC, registered at Police Station SGN. Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda.

While issuing notice of motion on 19.01.2016, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.44 dated 12.08.2015, under Sections 379/447/431/149 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station SGN. Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda.

Counsel would contend that the allegations are with regard to the petitioner as also co-accused having encroached upon a path leading to the land of the complainant and having also constructed a wall thereupon. Arguments raised is that at best it is a case of dispute with regard to demarcation of land and the petitioner in any case is ready and willing to join investigation.

Notice of motion, returnable for 05.04.2016.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/

Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Darshan Singh would inform the Court that not only has the petitioner since joined investigation but even a cancellation report is in the process of being presented before the competent Court.

Under such circumstances, prayer made in the present petition is accepted. Order dated 19.01.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.
