Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Anu in case FIR No.69 dated 15.04.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered with Police Station City Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

It is apparent that the complainant Rajinder Singh has been inflicted injury for taking a walk in their mohalla by the accused party comprising three persons including the petitioner-accused. The petitioner is attributed a *Datar* blow on the left side of the neck and another blow on the left knee and left shoulder of the complainant. The record bares out that the injury attributed to the petitioner-accused is grievous with sharp edged weapon on the neck and right knee.

Keeping in view the nature of the injuries and the role attributed to the petitioner, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
