JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.5.

2. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 4 only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, District Sirsa, Haryana to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated May 20, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if respondent No.3 finds that there is threat perception to the petitioners, he shall

provide the necessary protection, if so required.

5. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
