This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.327 dated 04.10.2015, registered under Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animal Act, 1960 and Sections 3, 4-A/8 of the Prohibition of Cow Slaughter Act, 1955, at Police Station Kalanaur, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is ready to join investigation in future as well.

the investigating officer states that the petitioner had joined investigation on 11.08.2016 but thereafter he did not appear despite the fact that notices were issued to him on three times.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that none of the notices were ever served upon him and the petitioner will handover his mobile number so that it is easy for the investigating officer to contact him when he requires his presence.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 26.05.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
