Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered on the complaint of Jagbir Singh alleging that the petitioner and his family members had misappropriated a sum of Rs.5lacs on the pretext of sending son and daughter-in-law of the complainant abroad. A sum of Rs.1 lac was given by cheque drawn on OBC Branch, Ajnala.

The petitioner has placed on record a civil suit filed by him for injunction pertaining to a house purchased by him vide registered sale deed from the complainant. In the written statement, Jagbir Singh, complainant has denied the execution of sale deed dated November 14, 2014.

There appears to be a dispute regarding some property. In said circumstances, it appears to be debatable whether the petitioner had received money for sending the son and daughter-in-law of the complainant abroad. As per the instructions of ASI Narpinder Singh, the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Interim order dated May 27, 2016 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
