Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 162, dated 25.10.2015, for offence punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.7, District-Jalandhar.

This Court, vide order dated 26.05.2016, has granted interim bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his joining the investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 26.05.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC-Sohan Lal, also submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 26.05.2016 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
